



## Erikasjalen / The Erika shawl

Start cluster = ch4, 2dc in space between tr and dc of previous row.

End cluster = (2dc, 1tr) in space between last dc of previous row and 4ch.

Shell = 2dc, 1ch, 2dc

Start : ch 4 and close with slipstitch in first ch st

row 1 ch3, (1dc, 4hdc, 1dc, 1tr) in ring, turn

row 2 ch4, (1dc, 1hdc) in next st, 2hdc in each of the next 4 sts, (1 hdc, 1dc) in next st, 1tr in between dc and 4ch of previous row.

row 3 Start cluster, skip 1st , shell in next st, skip 2sts \*, repeat between \*\* to end of row, shell in next st, skip 1 st, (2dc, 1tr) in space between last dc and tr of previous row, End cluster, turn, (4 shells)

row 4 Start cluster, 1sc in space between second dc and first shell, \* 5dc in 1ch sp of shell, 1sc in space between next 2 shells \* repeat from \* to \*, End cluster, turn

row 5 Start cluster, ch1, 1sc in next st, \* ch6, 1sc on center st of next dc cluster \*, 1sc on last dc, ch1, End cluster, turn

row 6 Start cluster, 2x (7dc in next ch sp), 9dc in next ch sp, 2x (7dc in next ch sp), End cluster, turn

row 7 Start cluster, skip 2 sts, shell in next stitch, \* skip 3 sts, shell in next st \* repeat from \* to \*, skip 2 sts, End cluster, turn (=10 shells)

row 8 as row 4

row 9 as row 5, (11 chain spaces).

row 10 Start cluster, ch1, sc in next st, \* ch 6, sc in ch sp, \* repeat to end, sc on last st, ch1, End cluster, turn (12 chain spaces)

row 11 as row 10, (13 chain spaces)

row 12 Start Cluster, 6x (5dc in next ch sp), 9 dc in next ch sp, 6x (5dc in next ch sps), End cluster, turn

row 13 as row 7



- row 14 as row 8
- row 15 as row 5
- row 16 as row 10
- row 17 as row 10
- row 18 Start cluster, 10x (5dc in next ch sp), 9 dc in next ch sp, 10x (5dc in next ch sp), End cluster, turn
- row 19 as row 7
- row 20 as row 8
- row 21 as row 5
- row 22 as row 10
- row 23 as row 10
- row 24 crochet dcs in the chain spaces as follows: 3x5, 1x4 , 3x5, 1x4, 3x5, 1x4, 7x5, 1x4, 3x5, 1x4, 3x5, 1x4, 3x5.
- Row 25 as row 7
- row 26 as row 8
- row 27 as row 5
- row 28 as row 10
- row 29 as row 10
- row 30 1x4, 3x5, 2x4, 3x5, 2x4, 3x5, 2x4, 3x5, 1x4, 1x5, 1x4, 3x5, 2x4, 3x5, 2x5, 3x5, 2x5, 3x5, 1x4, EC, turn
- row 31 as row 7
- row 32 as row 8
- row 33 as row 5
- row 34 + 35 as row 10



row 36      Start and end as before but fill the chain spaces as follows, 2x4, 3x5, 3x4, 3x5, 3x4, 3x5, 3x4, 3x5, 2x4, 1x5, 2x4, 3x5, 3x4, 3x5, 3x4, 3x5, 3x4, 3x5, 3x5, 2x4.

Every ch sp row crocheted as row 11 (equal to row 10) increases with a total of ten ch-6.

If you want your shawl bigger proceed as follows, add one 4dc cluster throughout:

row 42      BC, 3x4, 3x5, 4x4, etc.

row 48      BC, 4x4, 3x5, 5x4, etc.
